Dear friends of the Persecuted Church:

We just celebrated Christ the King Sunday. It is comforting and encouraging to remember that in spite of the madness and darkness all around us, CHRIST IS KING, and when He returns, all will be made right. In the meantime, we are His ambassadors, and His *advocates* here. Let's make the most of it!

Christians suffer more-and more severe-persecution than any other faith group. According to Open Doors World Watch List, *1 in every 8* Christians globally suffers persecution. In 2022, over 360 million Christians suffered severe levels of persecution, imprisonment, and death, an increase of 20 million over 2021.

In the closing months of 2023, we have seen the savage, murderous, and I would say *demonic* attack on Israel and the following outbreak of global anti-Semitism. Our elder brothers, the Jews, are the canary in the coalmine for what we could soon face in the West. At the same time, our ability in the West to stand up for them and for persecuted Christians has become more difficult because of that same growing darkness in our own nation. *This makes it even more necessary for us to fight for our own freedom, if we are to stand up for our persecuted brothers and sisters and others when our own government fails them.*

KGI Global Advocacy will provide a broad array of reports, articles, social media options, Bible studies, devotional series, and other resources to **equip** the Church's ministry to the persecuted by having knowledge, standing up for our own freedom, and being the kind of intercessors we need to be.

I need your help to continue to inform and inspire to advocacy by American Christians and others who care about justice and religious freedom.

Katartismos Global is small but can be mighty! As part of the Anglican Church in North America, we have amazing access and accountability to the worldwide Anglican family-much of which is persecuted-and through them, to other persecuted Christians. With Anglican William Wilberforce and other 18th-19th century British evangelicals we have a great legacy of human rights and religious freedom. *But we need your help to spread the word and urging your church family to become intercessors for the persecuted.*

June: Represented KGI Global at a dinner in honor of Nigerian Catholic bishop and priest at Belmont House; attended Congressional breakfast event sponsored by Assyrian Christians; attended special House Values Team meeting on Nigeria; [moderated a panel](#) on Egypt's Denial of Copts' Status and Rights as Indigenous Peoples at the Coptic Solidarity's annual conference; published [my article on the film Sound of Freedom](#) and child trafficking; and provided briefing to an Aglow team.
